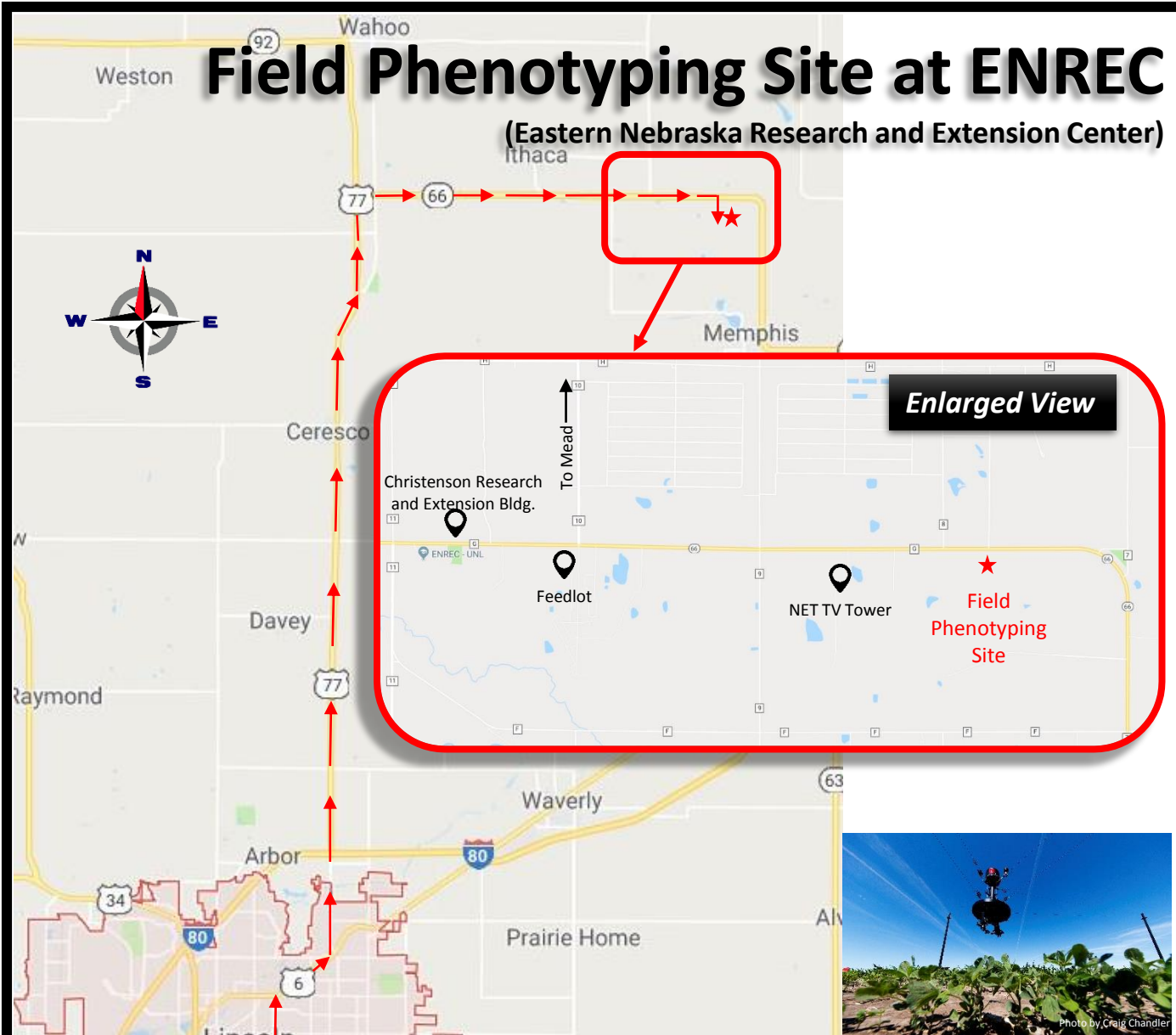


Field Phenotyping Site at ENREC

(Eastern Nebraska Research and Extension Center)



Address: 775 County Road G, Ithaca, NE 68033

Note: Google Maps will take you to an incorrect location about 1.3 miles west of the site.

GPS Coordinates: lat. 41.145687 lon. -96.439057

Directions from East Campus (approximately 33 miles or a 40 minute drive):

- Turn right (North) on to N 33rd Street – 0.6 miles
- Turn right (East) on to Cornhusker Hwy (US-6 E) – 2.0 miles
- Using the left two lanes turn left (North) on to N 56th St (Old Hwy 77)
- Travel 20.2 miles north on Hwy 77 to Nebraska Hwy 66, or 6 miles north of the town of Ceresco
- Turn right (East) on Nebraska Hwy 66 (also called County Road G) – 9.75 miles
- Field Phenotyping Site is on the right. Look for four 90' poles in the field.
- Go back the gravel lane and stop at the first gate.
- **Access to the site is restricted – an authorized person must be present.**

Other Directions:

- The site is on County Road G, 3.1 miles East of the Christenson Research and Extension Building, or 0.8 miles East of the drive leading back to the tall NET TV tower.
- **From Omaha:** take Hwy 92 west to the town of Mead. Turn left (South) on County Rd. 10, go 6 miles to the stop sign at Hwy 66. Turn left (East) and go 2.25 miles.
